SUBJECT: RESTAURANT PREMISES EXPANSION

We are in receipt of your letter dated September 11, 2020, with the request for certain allowances to expand the premises of restaurant dining spaces.

The County of Maui is open to your requests. See responses to your discussion points below:

1. Allowance of expansion of premises through outdoor dining on private property of up to 1,000 square feet in area temporarily for up to 12 months.

Several restaurants have already applied and received permission for expansion of their premises. If the business falls within SMA it will require SMA approval and exemption. This type of application qualifies for the expedited permit review process.

2. Allowance of outdoor dining on designated areas for parking of up to 1,000 square feet in area for up to 12 months.

This is already in place in Rule #1 for Designated Businesses and Operations under Exhibit "A" of Maui County's Public Health Emergency Rules. A copy of the Rules and Exhibit A is attached for your reference.

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3. Allow for automatic pre-approved or a streamlined approval process. If permits are not approved within 15 days, as per the Mayor's Covid-19 proclamation, then the necessary permits would be issued automatically.

The Mayor's Directive from May 28, 2020 states that "initial review" must happen within 15 days. Directive as stated reads "Initial review of building permits (that do not require electrical or plumbing permits) will be completed in 15 calendar days or the application will be considered approved." A copy of the Directive is attached for your reference.

Pursuant to Section 8-13.2 of the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, the Liquor Control Commission shall 1) adopt rules having the force and effect of law for the administration of liquor control laws and 2) grant, renew, or refuse applications for licenses for the manufacture, importation and sale of liquor in the County under applicable laws and regulations. Your requests for liquor permit changes will need to be addressed separately with the liquor commission.
